Amey Industrial Action

I can confirm I have today served a 14-day notice on AMEY for industrial action. The first day of action would be 1st August for 3 weeks, ending on Friday 19th August. I will be serving further notices during this period.

During this period there should be a 6-person picket line at both Elmbridge and Surrey Heath Depots. The remainder of GMB members can stand nearby but no more than 6 on a picket line.

AMEY management will go out of their way to create scare tactics - this is not unusual and totally expected. If you have any concerns at all you can call me on 07714239092.

The AMEY pay offer - drivers are already underpaid by at least £2 per hour if their current offer was implemented, much the same as everyone else. **AMEY'S profit after tax was £105.5 million pounds**. To say they cannot pay you a decent wage is scandalous and has become a race to the bottom in terms of pay.

I will be in touch over the next few days with any updates as required. I have also spoken to your GMB Branch, and they have confirmed there will be a hardship fund in place for you all.
