GMB MEMBERS HAVE SPOKEN: IT'S A NO FROM US **87% of GMB members Reject Pay Offer**

87% of GMB members in the NHS have voted to reject the pay offer. Our members, who have endured almost a decade of pay freezes and caps, have sent a clear message to Jeremy Hunt, that his 3 years real terms pay cut is not good enough.

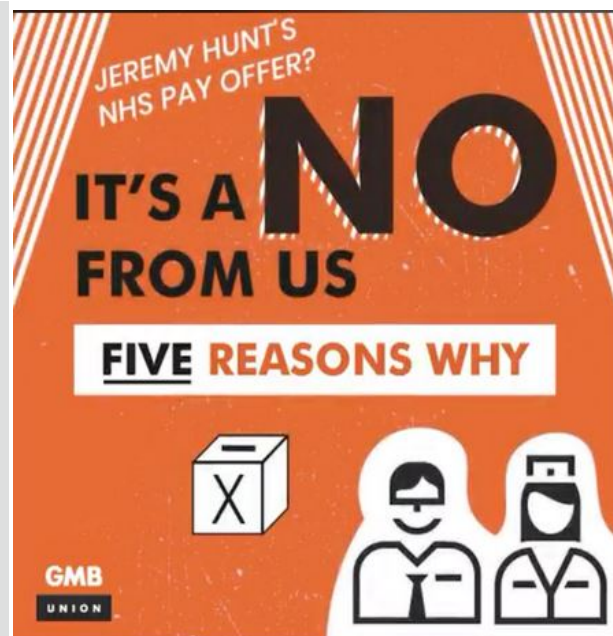
5 Reasons Why It's a NO from Us

1. GMB members say NO to a real term pay cut. Dedicated and loyal NHS staff, over half of who are already at the top of their pay bands, face an uplift of 6.5% over the next three years – way below forecast inflation.
2. GMB members say NO to funding their own pay increase by accepting cuts to unsocial hours and sick pay.
3. GMB members say NO to threats to cut the enhanced unsocial hours payments for new ambulance staff and existing ambulance staff changing roles.
4. GMB members say NO to incremental progression payments no longer being automatic and managers being able to block them.
5. GMB members say NO to private companies operating within the NHS cutting Agenda for Change terms and conditions.

GMB will continue the campaign for fairer pay for our NHS members. We will now be consulting with members in NHS England and the Ambulance Service to consider the next steps in this campaign. Keep an eye out for further communications and workplace visits in the next few weeks.
