

Dear Colleagues,

I can confirm the outcome of the ballot was <u>in favour of strike action</u> as 61.4 % voted YES and 38.6% voted NO.

I will be discussing the next steps with the Strike committee and come back to you. I do have to serve the Council a 14 day notice for action before any strike can take place.

Just as a reminder, do not disclose to management if you are willing to strike or not. It is not a requirement to inform them.

I also note that the predicted rate of inflation is now set as an expected 2.8% by quarter 4 in 2021. I have included over the page a guide on how the costs of general items has increased so far over the last 12 months.

Hopefully you will now see that not accepting the 1.3% offer was the correct thing to do. If you had accepted the offer it would effectively be a 1.5% pay cut if the Treasury projections are correct. Not a great way to start 2021!

You can also see that your story is being picked up by some local press outlets, such as the Surrey Comet. We will continue to use the press to put pressure on the Council to win you a new, better pay deal.
